3. Business Arising from Minutes (Chair)

4. Chair Report (Rob Barrow)

- The Chair gave a quick overview of the Alberta Seminar and events attached to the seminar and golf tournament.
- Eric Wyatt congratulated our Chair on becoming a member on the B149. 1 & 2 committees.
- The Chair announced that the 2020 CPA Leadership Summit will be in Edmonton, Alberta in May.

5. CPA Report – Darren Cunningham, CPA Regional Director, West

- The Regional Director discussed the Alberta government's Red Tape Reduction announcement of no longer do propane converted vehicles need to be re-certified every 5 years.
- As part of the CPA three-year Strategic Plan we are conducting a survey of members to bring priorities into focus and look for feedback on legislation or regulations that present an unnecessary burden on our industry.
- Cunningham outlined the CPA's efforts around Auto Propane Day on September 27th.
- E2 regulations came into effect August 24th; Spencer Buckland of ERAC will present information on the new E2 plans at the seminar.
- Cunningham discussed how CPA is working with the Standards Council of Canada on a study focused on the national labor mobility of the gas fitters trade.
- Members were updated on a Transport Canada pilot program on Electronic Shipping Documents.



6. National CPA Updates

Allan Murphy introduced the CPA's Propane Advantage election outreach program to the Alberta Committee members.

- The program is designed to get propane in the election conversation by reaching out to candidates in our member's ridings with an educational package.
- o CPA has sent our education package to the leaders of all of the federal parties.
- o Soon, there will be a CPA Propane Advantage video for sharing on social media.

Regulatory Affairs V.P. Rebecca Keeler updated the Committee on:

- The regulatory affairs survey of members on industry priorities and areas for potential administrative reductions – encouraging Alberta members to get involved.
- The ratification of a common Canadian CRN number, new Alberta government has still not signed on.
- CPA Board of Directors have approved in principle a study proposal on extending the recertification cycle on PRVs for 420 lb. cylinders to twenty-five years; in line with the United States.
- There was a quick discussion on direct fire vaporizers; that a docket has been filed at B149.2 in September asking to recognize the UL standard as the Canadian standard.
- When the discussion turned to water bath vaporizers needing a standard; Keeler suggested a sub-committee to study.
