SURVEY SAYS...

55% of respondents (up 25% from 2017) reported in the last 12 months there being **at least one crash** involving a moving vehicle at a highway work zone they operate.



26% (4% increase from 2017) reported construction worker injuries at the crash

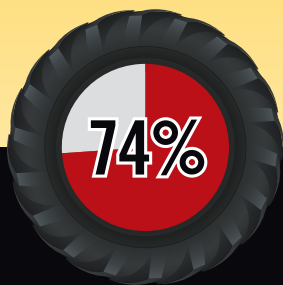


2% (82% decrease from 2017) reported construction worker fatalities at the crash

Nearly **3 out of 4** still feel motor vehicle crashes are a **greater risk today than they were a decade ago.**

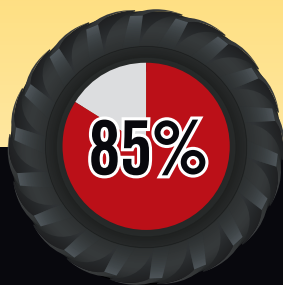


What would help reduce the number of crashes, injuries and/or fatalities in work zones?



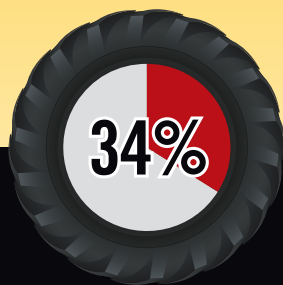

Stricter enforcement of existing laws



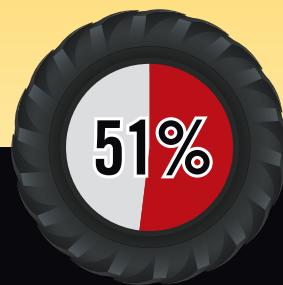
(4% increase from 2017)
