Exhibit sales for the November 5-6, 2025 trade show at the PNE in Vancouver will commence in the Fall of 2024. The BCEA and CIPH anticipate that the show will feature 250+ exhibitors, reserving 280+ booths. Exhibit sales for the November 3-4, 2027 trade show at the BMO Centre in Calgary will commence in the Fall of 2026. The AEA and CIPH anticipate that the show will feature 340+ exhibitors, reserving 370+ booths.
