- Three seats vacated due to resignations:
 - Assembly District 39
 - Prior Legislator: Raul Bocanegra
 - 53% Democrat 15% Republican
 - Assembly District 45
 - Prior Legislator: Matt Dababneh
 - 49% Democrat 23% Republican
 - Assembly District 54
 - Prior Legislator: Sebastian Ridley Thomas
 - 63% Democrat 9% Republican

Legislator of the Year

- Recommendation
 - Assemblymember Jim Frazier
 11th Assembly District



- Chair, Assembly Transportation Committee
- Strong Moderate Democrat
- Fought for the Useful Life Amendment
- Killed efforts to shift transportation funds away from fixing roads and highways
- District: Portions of Solano, Contra Costa, and Sacramento Counties
