Stop Shakedown Lawsuits – PAGA Reform Update

- Steering Committee submitted three versions for title and summaries
- Versions included- Full PAGA repeal, attorney's contingency fee cap, and attorney's fee-hourly rate
- Steering Committee supported full repeal
- Versions came back- very unfavorable to our cause

PAGA Reform Update continued

- Coalition met in mid December to discuss signature gathering collection costs
- Target number for this phase was estimated to be \$2.9 million to \$4.4 million
- Each group needed to commit \$250,000 for this phase
- Trucking industry (CTA) was one of three groups to commit

PAGA Reform Update continued

- Due to the lack of financial commitment from members of the Steering Committee it was recommended that the Steering Committee focus on a legislative strategy
- California Trucking Industry Issues PAC-
- PAC was created to intake funds that will go towards issues and reform efforts similar to the PAGA reform effort



PAGA Reform Update continued

- Funds will only be used following an approval from the Issues PAC Board
- Governance and process is being established
- Seeking CTA Board Approval to move forward on the establishment of the Issues PAC

Legislative Update – Safety Policy Committee Leg. Proposals

- AB 5 (Gonzalez Fletcher) Would mandate any new hours be offered to part-time employees before hiring new employees.
- Load Securement/Labeling (Choi) Increased penalties on all vehicles if something falls out onto the road and requires labeling of all items 12 inches long and more than 5 lbs
- Motor Carrier Permit "Modernization" Ensure vehicles under 10,000 lbs get a "Class C" MCP at a reduced rate of \$50.
- **PierPass** Asm O'Donnell working industry to develop a bill that addresses the lack of transparency in PierPass.
- **Weight Exemption (Frazier)** Reintroduction of SB 53 (Hueso) that would grant a 2,000 lbs weight exemption for natural gas and electric trucks.
